And then, please read and accept for Disclaimers.



- ❖ Exchange Message



2.1. Market Watch

Adding Scrip (Symbol)

- (1) Please click Add New to create Market Watch Name.
- (2) Please type Market Name which you want to define (eg: YSX) in Market Watch Name.
- (3) Then, Click Create.
- (4) Click "Add Scrip" to add Stock Share Name.
- (5) Please type Stock Share Name you want to see.
- (6) Then, Click Search.

- (7) You can add your search result Stock Share Name by clicking (+).
- (8) You can do creating other scripts as per above way.



2.2. Buying Stock Share

- (1) Please click “Buy” which you want to buy Stock Share.
- (2) Choose Order Type (Limit or Market)
 - ❖ Limit – You can choose ‘Limit’ if you want to define price limit.
 - ❖ Market – You can choose ‘Market’ if you want to buy as per Market price.
- (3) Qty – Please type order quantity.
- (4) After Market Order – If your order time is over market time, you can choose After Market Order for pre order.
- (5) Please check order information after submitting.
- (6) If ok, you can submit again to place order.



2.3. Selling Stock Share



- ❖ Order Cancel–Cancel data of order cancellation



You can see executed order in Trade book as follow.



Order can be rejected when you do the trade more than 20,000,000 MMK



Order can be rejected when you buy the trade with insufficient balance






❖ Net Margin Available – Available balance that can do trade



If you want to see detail, please click setting as shown in following figure.



- ❖ Then click submit. It will send alert to your registered email.



4. To Value (Amount)



You can see your personal data detail as following figure.



– To change password , Please follow the instruction as shown in figure.



– You can see your historylogs to trace as shown in figure.



Then , redirect to YSX website.


